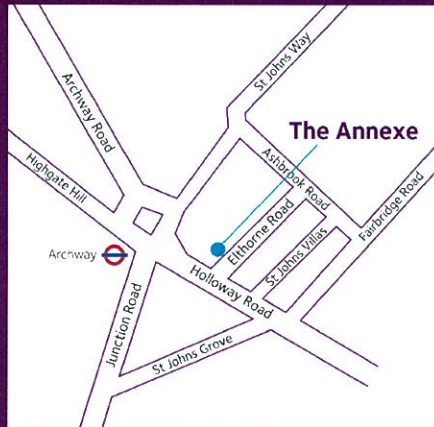
Getting to The Annexe

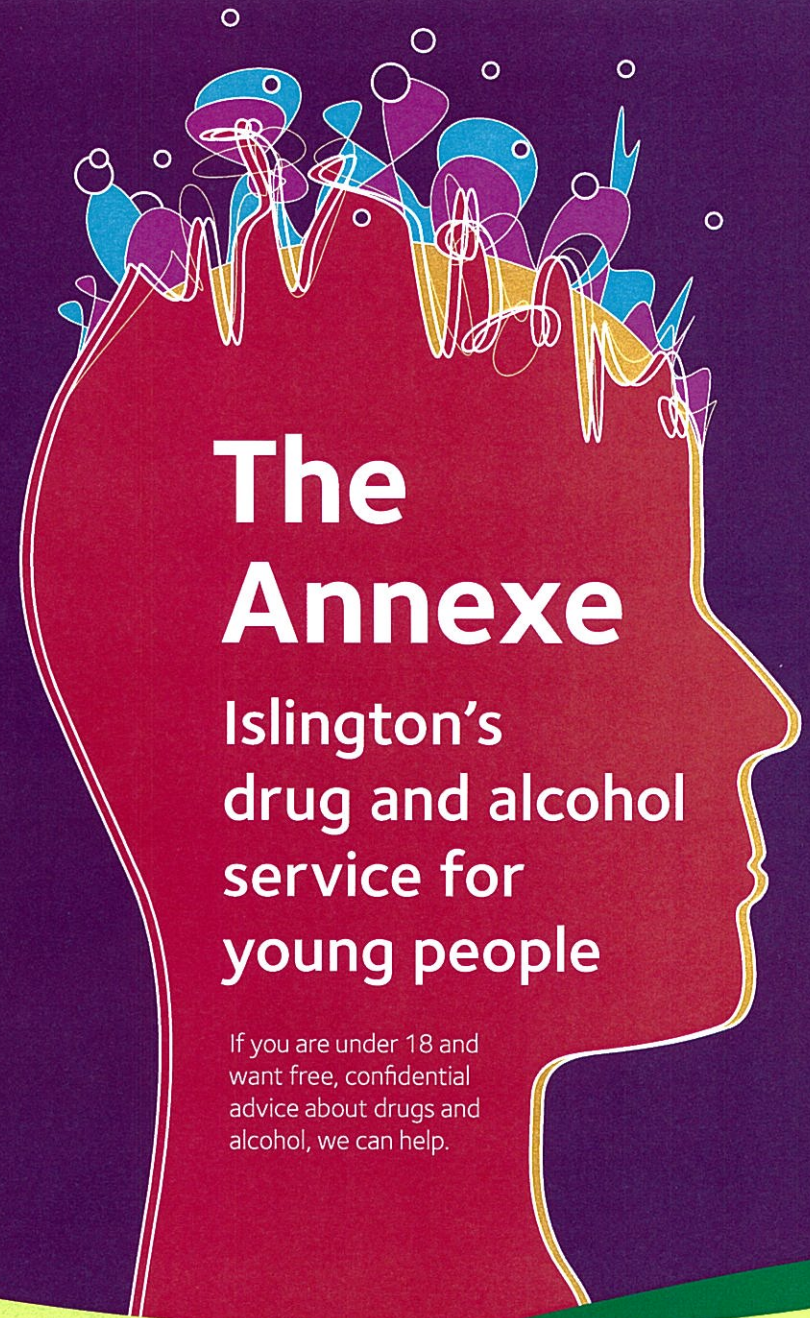

If you are under 18 and want free, confidential advice about drugs and alcohol, we can help.

What do we do?

We work with people aged eight to 18, who are using drugs, alcohol or solvents (e.g. glue).

We will give you honest information about how they work, what the risks are, and how you can reduce those risks. You do not have to want to stop using.

We can arrange substitute prescribing for drugs like heroin and alcohol and rehab if appropriate.

We can also help if you are worried about a friend or family member and their drink or drug use.

We have helped lots of young people and we can help you too.

I'm worried about people finding out!

We are a confidential service. We will only talk with other agencies if we are worried about your safety. If we do this, we will always tell you why.

What happens next?

You can text "drugs" and your first name to 60777* and someone will call you back.

You can call us on **0207 527 5099** for advice, information, or to make an appointment. If you prefer you can get someone else you trust to make the call.

We can arrange to meet in a place that's best for you.

- School or college
- Youth centres
